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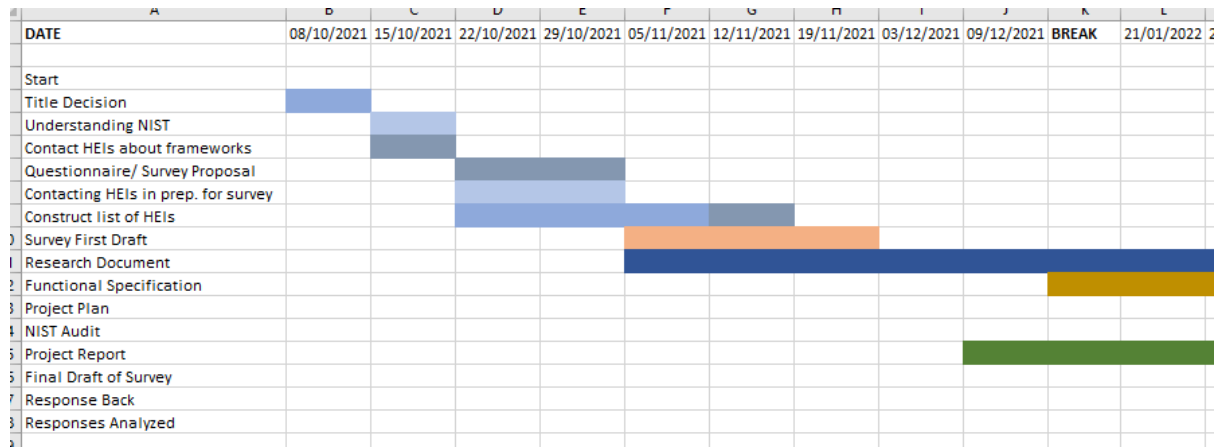
Introduction

The project plan is for displaying the timeline of the project and when it is projected to be finished. As will be displayed in the Gantt chart further on, the plan will go as follows;

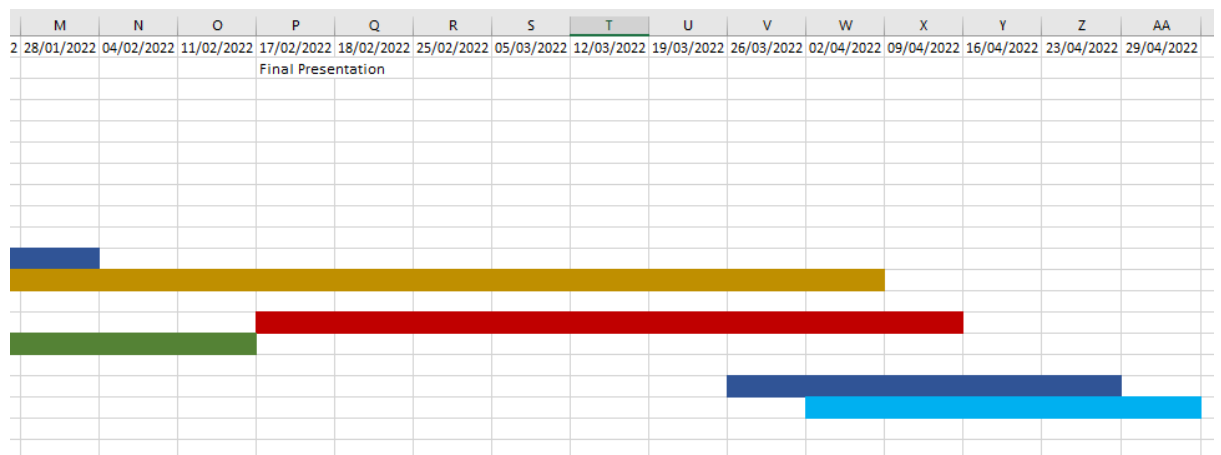
